HOW TO NOMINATE AN ALL-STAR

This is our invitation to you to become a nominator.

Recipients can be aerospace companies, individuals, workplace teams, or our partners in education or government. Posthumous nominations are also eligible. In a demanding industry where excellence is the baseline for performance, genuine excellence is key to the growth and success in our endeavors.

We strongly encourage you to recognize such excellence and to consider nominating your own organization, employees or colleagues, so that 'excellence' can be more widely recognized and rewarded.

Three All-Stars Awards of Excellence are presented annually. The following 12 categories are eligible for recognition:

5. Teamwork (emphasis on 'shop floor' and 'workplace teams')

11. Technology Development
12. Builder (*)

(*) The Builder Award recognizes an individual or group that has made a significant contribution to the infrastructure of Manitoba Aerospace for the benefit of the entire membership and in the interests of the provincial aerospace industry. The Builder Award will be awarded as merited, so there may not be a recipient every year.
